

Project Synopsis

CIF Project # 139 – Plastic Low Pressure Intrusion Technology

Background

In 2009, Rivalries Corporation was investigating new approaches to processing mixed plastics as it was evident that there was no long-term sustainable solution in Ontario. Research indicated that there was an opportunity to develop new equipment and processes that would better manage these types of material. Rivalries was granted funding to assist in building and testing the molding machines as well as funding for the future marketing of the machines and products.

Summary of Results

Rivalries commenced the development of the new equipment in the spring of 2010 and completed Phase One of the work in February 2011. The project was terminated without completion of the remaining phases.

Financials

The CIF had approved a budget of \$60,000. Only a partial amount of the total grant was paid (\$42,988) as the project was not completed.
