- CIF Wind Up Plan
- New CIF operations governance model
 - CIF Transition Services
 Committee (TSC)
 - CIF Windup Committee (WUC)
- RPRA Consultation
 - initiated

Timelines	Milestones
Sep 30, 2021	Cease provision of grants
Dec 31, 2023	 Continue the delivery of programs & support services, emphasis on transitional services Cease public operations by year end
Jun 30, 2024	 Initiate windup of CIF operation with an expectation that such activities will be completed by no later than June 30, 2024



CIF Status Update (2)

- 2021 Operations Plan
- Increased demand for CIF support services to help address

 - end market challenges
 - transition planning needs
